GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Tenderers shall deposit earnest money as prescribed in the tender call notice as a guarantee in good faith. The amount will be counted towards security for due performance of the contract. In the event of refusal to execute the agreement and non-commencement of the work, the same will be forfeited. If the tender is not accepted, the same amount will be refunded without any interest.
2. The Contractors may avail the Govt. Circular for non-submission of EMD as per Covid-19 Pandemic. However the declaration on Bid Security to be submitted for the purpose.
3. The 5% of the bill amount shall be deducted & kept at SERIFED as guarantee in good forth & towards security for due performance of the contract for a period of 5 years without any interest.
4. The agency shall visit the site & asses the details of works prior to submission of bid. The extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or other case shall be allowed.
5. The Agency shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all required materials tools & plants facilitation for works and maintain cleanliness to the work site without affecting the existing structures.

The damages caused to structures if any during execution of work shall be well attended by the Agency without any extra cost to the full satisfaction of the Authority.
6. The work should be executed as per required specification and direction of Engineer-in-Charge.
7. The Security amount shall be released to the Agency after six months of completion of service warranty period of 5 years without any complain on services.
8. The Agency must submit their bid latest by 5.00 PM on dt. 27.10.2022 as specified in contract data.
9. If the office happens to be closed on the last date of receipt of bids on scheduled, the bids will be received on the next working day at the same time & venue.
10. The work shall be executed within a months time. The Agency having necessary expertise & compency to complete the work within stipulated time in such a sophisticated environment of Odisha Crafts Museum should participate in the bid process.
11. The Volume & items of work may vary (may be less or excess) at discretion of Authority & final payment to the Agency shall be regulated on the basis of actual work executed on the approved rates only.
12. No part of the work will be sub-let which may lead to use of inferior quality of materials / chemicals & shall be reviewed seriously. In such case the Authority may take step for withholding of entire payment deduction as deemed frit.
14. 5% deduction will be made from each running bill/ Final bill as security for due execution of the works.& 1% work cess deduction will be made from R/A Final bill for Workers welfare.
15. Time allowed for carrying out the work as entered in the tender, shall be strictly observed by the contractor and shall be reckoned from the date on which the order to commence work is given to him.
16. The quantities in the "Schedule of quantities" are only estimated and are liable to alternations by omissions, deductions or additions at the discretion of the Employer. The tenderer shall after due study of the specifications, the mode of measurement fill up and scrutinize properly the form of tender and the schedule of quantities without addition any stipulations thereto. The schedule of quantities shall show the amounts and the total correct to two decimal places in the columns provided, as also the granted totals as required. All entries shall be made in ink and in English, corrections if any, should be initiated. Over writing of figures is not permitted.
17. The rates quoted shall be firm exclusive of GST. The rates shall be firm and shall not be subject to change on variations in layout, conditions or any other conditions whatsoever and shall hold good till the completion of works and shall also includes all charges for scaffolding, supply of water, materials and such other general work as per specification of PWD, Govt. of Odisha.
18. The rate should be quoted in words & figures. In case of discrepancies in words & figures, the rates in words shall prevail & in case of discrepancies between unit rates and totals, the unit rates shall prevail. The tender shall be written legibly and free from erasures, over writings or conversions of figures. Corrections where non-avoidable should be made by scoring out initialing, dating and re-writing. The tender should also show the total of each page and grand total of whole tenders.

19. The contractors will be responsible for payment of royalties or other charges for quarrying materials. All local taxes inclusive of GST, I.T, ferry and tollage charges are to be paid by the contractors or any taxes levied by Govt. of Odisha.
20. I.T.C.C & S.T.C.C.
The tender may not at the discretion of the competent authority be considered unless accompanied with attested true copy of the I.T. clearance (PAN Card)/GST clearance as the case may be and the original certificates to be produced before the authority at the time of the opening of the tenders.
21. The Contractor should be fully liable to indemnify the Department for payment of any compensation under Workmen's Compensation Act-VIII of 1928 on account of the workmen being employed by him and the full amount of compensation paid will be recovered from the contractor.
22. Every tenderer must examine the detailed specifications of Odisha before submitting his tender. The right is reserved without impairing the contract to make such increase or decrease in the quantities of or times of work mentioned in the schedule attached to the tender notice as may be considered necessary to complete the work fully and satisfactorily. Such increase shall in no case invalidate the contractor's rates. It shall be definitely understood that the authority does not accept any responsibility for the correctness or completeness of the quantities shown in the schedule. The schedule is liable to alteration by omissions or additions or deductions and shall omission, deductions shall be in no case invalidate the contract and no extra monetary compensation will be entertained.
23. No departmental materials will be supplied to the contractor for the above noted work from departmental store. All the materials required for the work will be arranged by the contractor at his own cost.
24. All reinforced cement concrete work should conform to detailed specification of works of **Works Dept., Govt. of Odisha** and should be of grade M 200 with 12 mm to 20 mm size black hard crusher broken granite stone chips (20 mm size not be exceed 25%) having minimum compressive strength (in work test) 150 kg/200 kg/cm in 15 cm cubes at 28 days after mixing & tests conducted in accordance with IS 456-2000 and grade of steel HYSD Fe 500 D confirming to the relevant Indian standard code of practice.
25. Shuttering and centering shall be with seasoned sal wood planks the inside of which shall be lined with suitable sheeting and made leak-proof and water tight or alternatively steel shuttering and centering may be used.
26. For the purpose of jurisdiction in the event of dispute if any contract should be deemed to have entered into within Bhubaneswar and it is agreed that, neither party to the contract nor the agreement will be competent to bring a suit in regard to the matters covered by this contract at any place outside the state of Odisha.
27. After the work is finished all surplus materials and debris are to be removed by the contractor and preliminary works such as Vats, Mixing platforms, etc. are to be dismantled and all the materials are to be removed from the site. No extra payment will be made to the contractor on this account. The rate quoted should be inclusive of all these items. The ground up to 5 mtr shall be cleared and rough dressed.
28. The contractor shall not interfere with the execution of water supply or electrical fitting arrangement^{5s} and any other work entrusted to any other agency by the Dept. at any time during the progress of the works.
29. The Department will have the rights to inspect the scaffolding and centering made for the work and can reject partly or fully such structures if found defective in their opinion.
30. The contractor will have to arrange for water supply for all works and made sanitary arrangements at his own cost for his labour camps. The contractor has to arrange adequate lighting arrangements for night works wherever necessary at his own cost.
31. Bailing out water from the foundation either rain water or sub-soil water if necessary should be borne by the contractor. No payment will be made for bench marks, level pillars, profiles, benching and leveling ground where required. The rates quoted should be for finished items of work inclusive of those incidental items of works.

32. All the quantities mentioned in the schedule are applicable in all conditions prevailed at site and the rates should be through for the same or as indicated in the tender.
33. Cement concrete in columns, beams and wherever prescribed by the Engineer-in-charge shall be machine mixed and vibrated, and the contractor should arrange his own concrete mixers, vibrators, pumps etc. for the purpose.

37. The work will be executed as per the instruction of the Managing Director/ Engineer In charge and in accordance with the specifications.
38. The tenderers must obtain for himself on his own responsibility and at his own expenses all the information’s, which may be necessary for the purpose of submitting the tender and for entering into a contract and must examine the drawing & must consider to inspect the site of the work and acquaint himself with all local conditions, means to access to the work, nature of the work and all matters relating thereto. He should also inspect all the quarries and get himself satisfied about availability and quality of the materials required for the work.
39. The contractor has to deposit the additional performance security in shape of DD as per PWD norms with the Financial Bid document for finalization of Tender urgently.
 - i) 5% to 10% - 50% of difference between estimated cost put to tender to Bid amount.
 - ii) 10% to above – 150% of difference between estimated cost put to tender to Bid amount.
40. The successful tenderer is bound to carry out all items of work necessary for the completion of the job, even though such items are not included in the schedule of quantities.
41. All fittings of required for work, supplied by the contractors should be of best quality and should be got approved by Engineer in charge before they are used on the work.
42. The contractor shall carry at his own cost such tests as are required by the authority concerned and those that may be required by the Engineer I/c. He shall at his own cost rectify all defects in workmanship and materials and pay all charges and fees for the same.
43. The contractor whose tender is accepted shall enter into regular contract agreement in the prescribed form with M/s Orissa Co-op. Tasar & Silk Federation Ltd. embedding the conditions in addition to this tender with bill of quantities and prices filled therein, specifications and general drawings as per the conditions prescribed in the approved form of agreement.
44. The contractor shall execute any extra work, over and above that shown in the drawings and described in the specifications/ bill of quantities and allow for any emitted work, as may be ordered by the Engineer at the same prices in accordance with the terms and condition contained in the annexed schedule of prices and the conditions of contract.
45. All the materials shall be in accordance with the Orissa Standard Specification of **Works Dept., Govt. of Odisha** and in absence of such specifications standards specified by I.S.I. relevant to the work.
46. The employers reserves the right to withdraw any item of the work shown in the bill of quantities attached to the specifications for which the contractors has quoted for, after giving him 7 days notice thereof.
47. All the materials and workmanship shall be of best possible description & to the full satisfaction of the employer. The contractor shall immediately remove from the premises any materials and/ or work which in the opinion of the employer are defective or unsuitable and shall substitute with proper materials or work at his own cost. Samples of materials proposed to be used are to be approved by the employer before actual use in the work.
48. The contractors shall not assign the work or sublet any portion of the work without the written consent of the employer.
49. Incase of any ambiguities, the decision of the Managing Director will be final.

52. All plants, machineries tools, trucks etc. required for the work will be arranged by the contractor at his cost.

60. All reinforced cement concrete works should be finished smooth. Extra charges for plastering is required to any R.C.C. structures like columns, beams, chajas etc. shall be paid as per requirement.
61. The tenderer may at his opinion quote reasonable rate for each item of work carefully so that the rate for one item should not be unworkably low and for others too high.
Items where the rates quoted by the tenderer are less than 25% below the CSR/estimated rates the differential cost between the estimated amount and tender amount shall be withheld till the satisfactory completion of such items having low rates.
